**Notes**

1. Number of posts / vacancies are tentative and the recruitment process can be cancelled/ suspended/ terminated by the appointing authority at any stage, due to administrative reasons.

2. Multi-Tasking Staff – (Ser No 22) is required to perform duties of Safaiwala / Watchman / Gardner / Messenger and any other task as chosen by the appointing authority. Lascar – (Ser No 23) is required to perform duties of loading, unloading, digging and other tasks requiring manual labour.

3. PwBDs and ESM Vacancies. Out of the total 119 vacancies, 12 vacancies for ESM and 04 vacancies for PwBDs candidates will be reserved from within the reserved and unreserved vacancies for the posts as shown in the Table above.

**4. Online Application Form, Educational and other qualifications and Age Limit**

(a) **Online Application Form:** - (i) Only online application will be accepted. (ii) Online application with mandatory undertaking / forms to be uploaded by the candidate is available at <https://cmepune.edu.in>. (iii) Candidates should NOT send any application printouts or certificates or copies to CME by post. (iv) Candidates may apply for only one post in one online application. However, a maximum of three separate online applications for three different posts may be filled by a candidate mentioning their priority of post in the space given in the online application form.

(v) Any future amendments / corrigendum in the advertisement will be published in <https://cmepune.edu.in>.

(b) **Educational and other qualifications:** - Essential educational qualification, essential experience and desirable qualification (where applicable) for each post are as given in the table above.

(c) **Age Limit:** - (a) All posts for UR are 18 to 26 years except for CMD (Ord Gde) which is 18 to 30 years. The crucial date for determining age limit shall be the last date for receipt of application. Age relaxation criteria for candidates from reserved categories, for PwBDs and for ESM candidates is available at <https://cmepune.edu.in>.

(d) **Last date of submission of online application:** - (i) The last date of receipt of online application at: <https://cmepune.edu.in> is 25 Feb 2023. (ii) Candidates are responsible for providing all factually correct data and correct certificates / documents. Providing factually incorrect data, fake certificates / documents or providing incomplete certificates / documents by the candidate will result in automatic rejection of his / her candidature.

(e) Persons working in Central Govt / State Govt / PSUs must also forward a printout of the application through the competent authority of his / her present organisation to Recruitment Cell, F CBRNP, CME, Dapodi, Pune-411031 by 25 Mar 2023. Admit Card will not be issued in case of non-receipt or late receipt of copy of the applications at CME, Pune.

**5. Screening Written Test and Skill / Practical Test**

(a) Mere submission of online applications(s) does not entitle candidates to be called for the written test.

(b) The number of candidates to be called for the written test will be restricted as per the merit of the candidate in the educational and other qualifications required. The number of candidates being called for the skill / practical test will be restricted.

(c) Skill / Practical test will be carried out in respect of LDC, CMD (Ord Gde) and Cook post only.

(d) Shortlisted candidates will be intimated later via email on their registered email ID about the status of their application(s). The organisation will not be responsible for non-receipt of intimation due to inactive / incorrect email ID. The candidates should check their status and shortlisted candidate should download their Admit Card approx 30 days after the last date of submission of the application(s) from <https://cmepune.edu.in>.

(e) No extra weightage will be given to additional qualifications / experiences other than those mentioned above.

(f) Syllabus for written test alongwith breakdown of marks has been provided in detail on <https://cmepune.edu.in>.

(g) The examination centre will be in Pune, Maharashtra.

(h) Candidates will be responsible for their meal, travel and accommodation arrangements for the written test and skill / practical test. No TA/DA will be provided.

(i) Though the candidates can apply for multiple posts. Admit Card for examination will be issued for only one post per candidate based on the merit and priority of post filed by the candidate.

(j) PwBDs candidates desirous of availing the services of scribe / reader for the written test, should make arrangements for the scribe / reader at their end, and must mandatorily produce certificate(s) at Appendix I, Appendix II and Appendix III as given at <https://cmepune.edu.in> at the written test. No scribe / reader will be provided by CME, Pune for the written test.

(k) Candidates are required to report for the written test, skill / practical test (where applicable) with identity proof (Passport, Aadhaar Card, PAN Card, Driving License, Voter's Card) and Admit Card. PwBDs candidates availing the services of a scribe / reader for written test must produce certificates as mentioned at Para 5 (j) above (Appendix I, Appendix II and Appendix III).

(l) For the written test and skill / practical test, candidates are required to carry blue / black ball point only.

(m) The candidate must always wear mask, use sanitizer, maintain social distancing at examination centre and strictly follow the Covid-19 guidelines.

**6. Mode of selection**

(a) All applications will be scrutinized in terms of age limit, educational and other qualifications as given above, and documents, forms and certificates uploaded by candidate on <https://cmepune.edu.in>.

(b) The shortlisted candidates will be required to appear for the written test. The written test will be of Objective Type of multiple choice questions of 10<sup>th</sup> / 12<sup>th</sup> / Degree level corresponding to the post applied for.

(c) The written test will consist of (i) General Intelligence & Reasoning (ii) Numerical Aptitude (iii) General English (iv) General Awareness.

(d) The question paper will be in English and Hindi except for General English paper.

(e) The requisite number of candidates will be shortlisted and called for skill / practical test (LDC, CMD (Ord Gde) and Cook posts) based on their category and merit in the written test. The candidates should check their status and shortlisted candidate should download their Admit Card from <https://cmepune.edu.in>. (f) The skill / practical test being only qualifying in nature, final selection of the candidates will be based on their category and marks obtained by candidates in the written test subject to qualifying in skill / practical test.

7. The decision of appointing authority regarding selection / rejection will be final.

8. Candidates on selection are liable to be transferred anywhere in India.

9. To avoid last minute rush, candidates are advised in their own interest to submit ONLINE applications well before the closing date since there may be a possibility of inability / failure to log on to the website on account of heavy load on the internet or website jam during last days.
